

Charcoal Graffiti removal instructions

So what do you do if you find charcoal graffiti? If it is in your site or close to archaeological resources contact Hayley with impact report and photos. If it is in any other area you may clean it up following Hayley's instructions. Please do send before and after photos and location.

To clean up the charcoal you do need some tools. It's best to have a stiff paint brush and follow along on the lines of the charcoal to dust off the thick layers. I used a three inch paint brush that was cut down about one-inch from the handle to make it stiffer. Then I usually have a little bit of water in a bucket with a drop of dawn dish soap and give the charcoal line a quick scrub and then dump clean water over it.

Supplies: Stiff paint brush, old toothbrush, Dawn, water and bucket.
